

BIPLAB BARDAN A MANGO GROWER

Block, Gomati District has converted his medium upland vegetable plot of about 0.16 kani under mango (Amrapalli) cultivation about three years back. Earlier this plot was used to vegetable such as chilli, brijal, potato etc. and used to sold in the market to supplement his family income.

During the year 2012-13, he has planted 130 numbers of mango (Amrapali) graft with the financial and technical guidance under the scheme of HMNEH. In this season, he has harvested about 120 kg of mango shell of which market value is `5,000.00.

He has inspired to grow mango plantation by seeing another farmer



Sirazul Islam which is well known to him.



In this plot, at present he is not only growing mango but also cultivating vegetables such as chilli, brinjal, tomato, cucumber as inter crop and he has earned about `2,000.00 during this season.

He is expecting more income from this mango plantation in coming seasons and he will nourish the plot accordingly. The mango plot has created a extra source of income for his family.
